

Member Only Shooting

The undersigned member (hereinafter “Member”) has requested permission of Sportsmen’s Gun and Reel (hereinafter “SGR”) to be permitted to utilize SGR facilities during times other than regularly scheduled public shooting. SGR has agreed to extend facilities use as requested, upon the following terms and conditions:

1. Member will at all times adhere to all SGR rules and policies with respect to gun safety, including but not limited to: proper muzzle control; loading of firearm only at designated post with a single round (or two if shooting doubles) when ready to fire; keeping firearm empty when anyone is down range attending to clay target machines; and keeping all firearm actions open when not in use.
2. Member will be required to successfully complete an orientation as may be designated from time to time by the Board of SGR. Member shall not be permitted to shoot during non-public hours without such orientation. Training and orientation will include a refresher of SGR safety protocol, proper operation of clay target machines, and general Member responsibilities with respect to SGR facilities. Member shall at all times follow the directives received during orientation and any additional rules as may be promulgated by the Board thereafter.
3. Member will be provided the combination for the front gate lock. Member shall at all times keep such combination confidential and shall not disclose same to anyone. Member will be permitted to unlock the gate for passage, but must immediately close same before proceeding further onto SGR property. At no time shall Member allow said gate to remain open beyond the time necessary for passage. While on SGR property, gate is to remain closed but unlocked for emergency vehicles.
4. Member shall use only such facilities and clay target machines as designated by the SGR Board and communicated during orientation. Member shall be responsible for using safe procedures to initiate operation of the clay target machines and keeping same stocked with clay targets. Upon concluding shooting, Member will be required to safely shut down all clay target machines and properly refill same with clay targets. Member shall likewise properly “close up” all houses or enclosures containing said clay target machines. It shall be the responsibility of Member at all times to keep SGR facilities cleaned up and otherwise free of loose shells and debris.
5. Member only shooting shall be between the hours of 9:00 a.m and sundown. Member must be 21 years of age or older. Youth trap team members may also shoot during non-public hours, but only if accompanied by a designated and SGR Board approved team coach. No shooting or use of SGR facilities at any other time is

permitted. Member shall sign in upon arrival and sign out prior to departure. Member shall also record the number of rounds shot, designating same as trap or sporting in accordance with the form provided by the SGR Board.

6. Any violation of the directives contained herein or the rules and procedures of SGR will result in suspension of the right of Member to shoot during non-public hours. The Board of SGR will consider any such violation and issue a decision with respect to same. The Board shall be vested with exclusive authority to extend, restrict, modify or otherwise deny any Member rights herein.
